



Board and Train Agreement

and Tara Walzel acting as agent for Master's Voice Canine Training, LLC (hereinafter known as "Trainer") pertains to the following:

For good and valuable consideration, the parties agree as follows:

Training Fees:

Client agrees to pay Trainer 50% of current board and train rate (less deposit) at start of session and the remainder upon completion of stay. A \$150.00 deposit is required at time of booking. Rates are as follows and includes training package consisting of: slip leash and/or 6' leather leash, non e-collar training collar, training pouch and elevated pet bed in appropriate size for Dog. Board and train services include 1 go home lesson for approximately 1 hour, and 1 follow-up lesson within 3 weeks of completion for approximately 1 hour.

- a. \$1000.00 for 2 weeks (\$500.00 less deposit at drop off and \$500.00 at completion) OR
- b. \$1350.00 for 3 weeks (\$675.00 less deposit at drop off and \$675.00 at completion) OR
- c. \$1650.00 for 4 weeks (\$825.00 less deposit at drop off and \$825.00 at completion).

Services:

Trainer agrees to provide consistent, daily, one-on-one training with Dog at Trainer's Facility in effort to instill basic obedience and achieve Client's behavioral priorities for Dog. Although Trainer will use all reasonable care to train Client's Dog, Trainer cannot guarantee that dog will respond adequately at all times. Client agrees that Trainer will not be liable for any damage or loss resulting from the Dog's failure to respond to any cue(s) or behavior modification for which Trainer trained the dog. Trainer agrees to train Client's Dog in reasonable manner, however the effectiveness of the completed training program depends on many factors over which Trainer has no control. Such factors include, but are not limited to, the genetic tendencies of the breed and/or temperament of the Dog, the future health of the Dog, the frequency and effectiveness of training reinforcement which Client must give the Dog, and the degree of leadership and structure which Client provides for the dog.

Refund/Cancellation Policy:

If Client cancels 72 hours or more before scheduled drop off, deposit is 100% refundable. If Client cancels 24-72 hours prior to drop off, \$100.00 of deposit is refundable. If cancellation occurs 24 hours or less, or fails to show up for scheduled training session, deposit is forfeited. In the event of personal emergency or illness of Trainer, Trainer will contact client immediately and a refund for remaining time will be made, and/or training will be rescheduled.

Abandonment Policy:

Dog shall be deemed abandoned if Client fails to pick up Dog on the day for pick up indicated above, or if Client fails to pay applicable charges. If Client does not pick up Dog and all charges settled within 7 days from the date Trainer mails to Client (at address indicated above) written notice that Dog is considered abandoned, Trainer may either sell Dog to recover incurred costs, or deliver Dog to a humane society, rescue organization or other person as an abandoned pet and Trainer shall have no further responsibility for Client's Dog. Client will continue to accrue and be liable for unpaid charges, including boarding charges until Dog is sold or delivered as an abandoned pet.

Requirements:

Dogs in heat or that are ill will not be allowed to attend Board and Train sessions. Dogs must have all required vaccinations or proof of protective titers for the following: DHPP (Distemper, Hepatitis, Parainfluenza, and Parvovirus) and Bordetella (Kennel Cough). A copy of proof of vaccines or titers must be presented at start of session. Dogs must also be on a heartworm preventative and a flea and tick preventative and the Client must provide these medications for the Dog if required during the course of the session. All dogs will be inspected for fleas at time of intake and if found will be given a dose of Capstar at Client's expense. Trainer may refuse to accept (or may terminate this Agreement and require Client to immediately pick up) any Dog whose health, condition or behavior could jeopardize the health or safety of Master's Voice Canine Training, LLC personnel or other animals.

Client understands that other dogs will attend Master's Voice Canine Training, LLC's programs and during the course of participation Dog may come into direct contact with other participating dogs. Dog will also be exposed to a variety of training surfaces and weather conditions. Trainer will occasionally transport Dog to locations other than home facility in order to "generalize" commands and behaviors.

Client agrees to release photos and videos of Dog's likeness obtained during course of training for use in promotional materials by Trainer.

If Dog becomes sick or injured during the course of training, Client agrees to grant Trainer the authority to engage the services of a veterinarian of Trainer's choice. In non-emergent situations every effort will be made to contact Client prior to any treatment. Charges by Trainer or any veterinarian for services performed shall be paid by Client.

Liability:

If Dog causes property damage, or bites or injures any dog, animal or person (including but not limited to Trainer and Trainer's agents), during or after the term of this Agreement, then Client agrees to pay all resulting losses and damages suffered or incurred, and to defend and indemnify Trainer and Trainer's agents from any resulting claims, demands, lawsuits, losses, costs or expenses, including attorney fees. If Dog is injured in a fight or in any other manner during or after the term of the Agreement, Client assumes the risk and agrees that Trainer should not be held responsible for any resulting injuries, losses, damages, costs or expenses.

At Trainer's sole election, Trainer's duties hereunder shall terminate if (a) in Trainer's sole judgment Dog is dangerous or vicious to Trainer or any other person or animal, or interferes with the training of other dogs, or (b) Client breaches any term or condition of this Agreement. Upon termination in accordance with the foregoing, Trainer's duties shall terminate but all other provisions of this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect.

This Agreement is binding upon Client, spouse of Client, and children of Client. This Agreement supersedes all prior discussions, representations, warranties and agreements of the parties, and expresses the entire agreement between Client and Trainer regarding the matters described above. The parties confirm that, except for that which is specifically written in this Agreement, no promises, representations or oral understandings have been made with regard to Dog or anything else. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Client acknowledges that Trainer has not represented, promised, guaranteed or warranted that Dog will never bite, that Dog will not be dangerous or vicious in the future, that Dog will not exhibit other behavioral problems, or that the results of the training will last for any particular amount of time. This Agreement may be amended only by a written instrument signed by both Client and Trainer.
